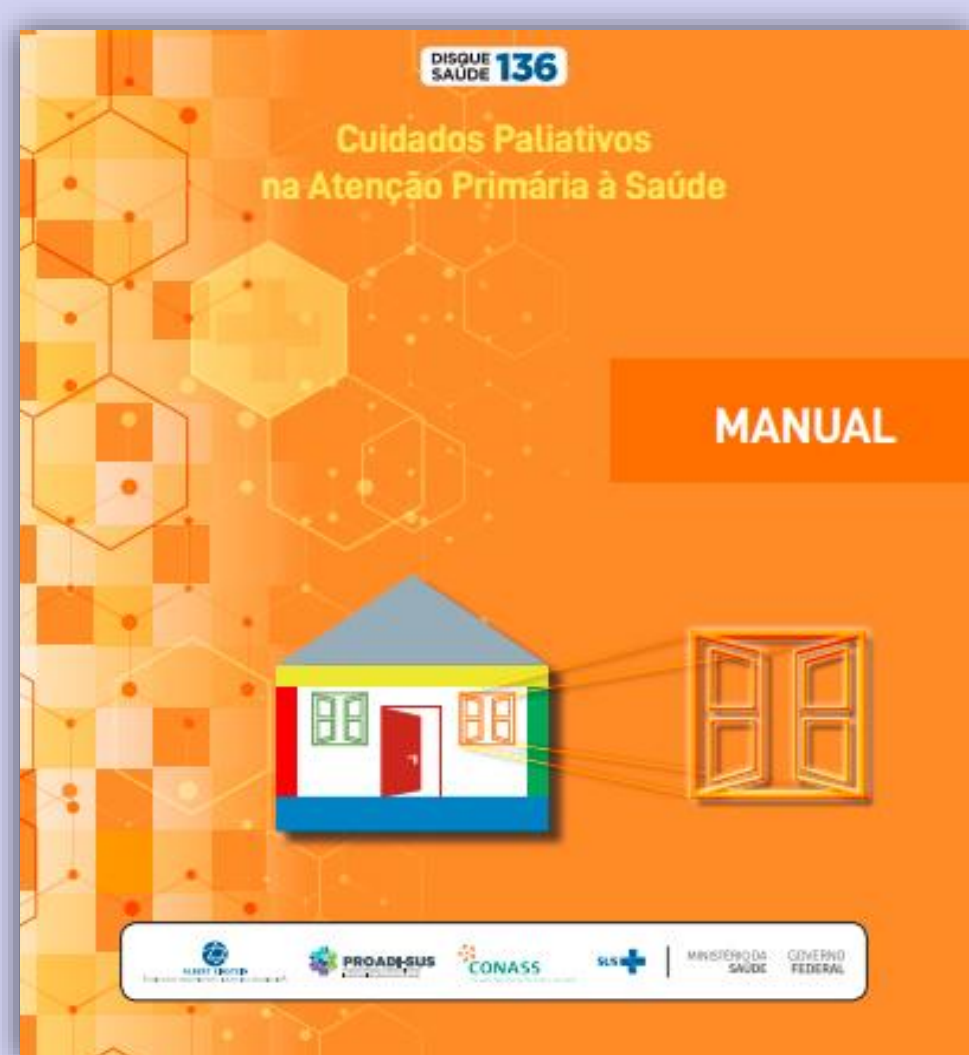

## Introduction

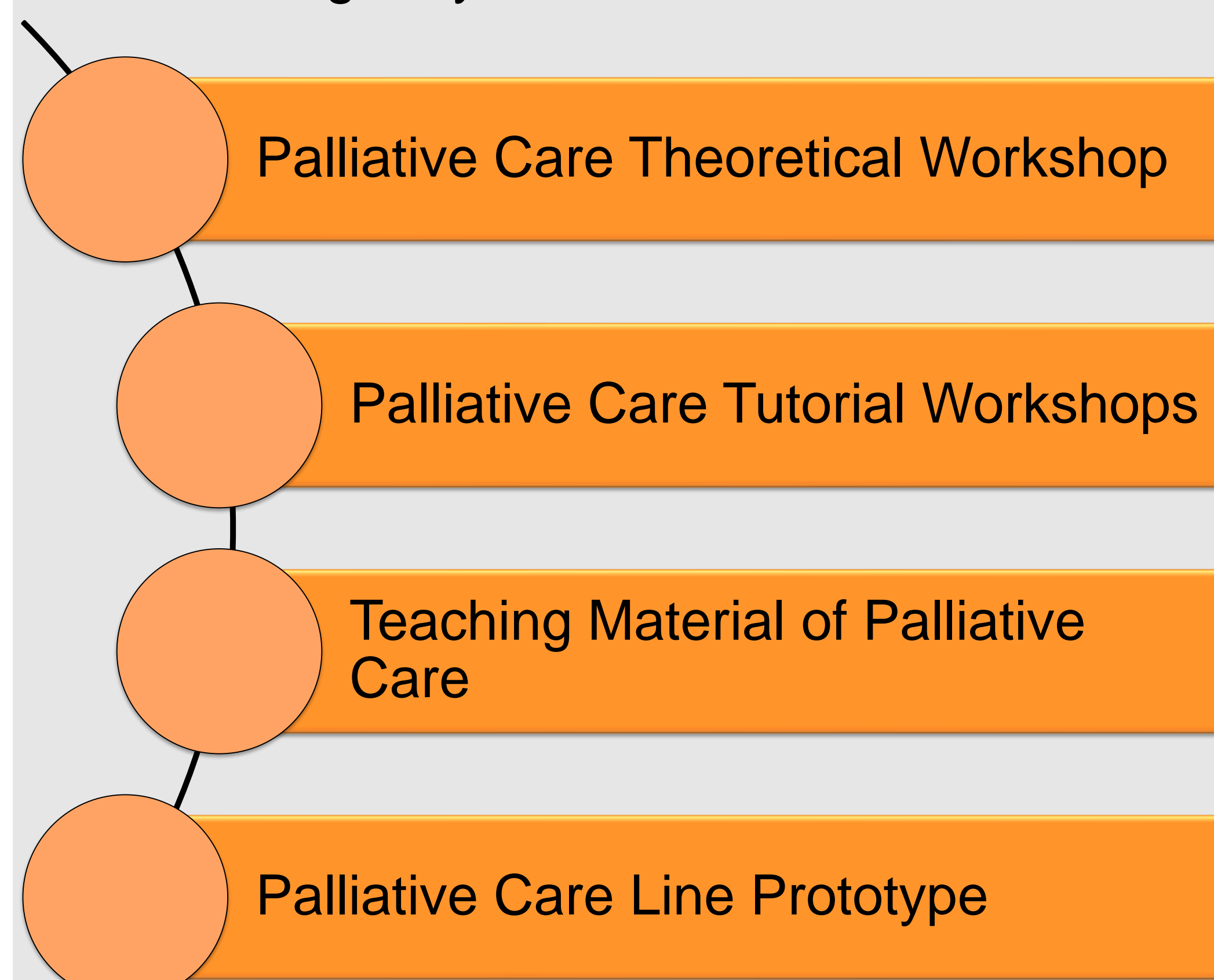
Assistance in Palliative Care (PC) in Brazil occurs very related to the hospital context. Considering the need for this care in a community context, a pilot project was carried out in order to implement PC macroprocesses in Primary Health Care (PHC), through the Health Care Planning (HCP) methodology.
