










# Implementation of Palliative Care Macroprocesses in Primary Health Care Center in Brazil: Results of Health Care Planning

## Introduction



Is it possible to promote the development of PHC through changes in work processes to provide quality palliative care in the community context?


#### Methods

The HCP methodology presented the project methodologically divided into:




## Results
